UUCLV Policy on Alcohol storage within UUCLV or on-site

Policy Statement


The Board of Trustees (BOT) of the Unitarian Universalist Congregation of Las Vegas (UUCLV), recognizing the possible liabilities associated with the storage of alcoholic beverages on site at UUCLV, adopt the following guidelines for the storage and use of alcohol and alcoholic beverages on UUCLV owned property.

Procedures

Alcohol is allowed to be served on UUCLV property **only** at UUCLV sponsored or sanctioned events. Alcohol beverages must stored in a locked storage area, with keys only available to persons over the age of 21. No key to such locked area may be kept in a location available to all members and visitors of the congregation.

Alcohol beverages may only kept on-site when planning a specific congregation related event, and then only for a maximum of three (3) days previous to the event, and two (2) days after the event. After that time, the alcoholic beverages shall be removed from the property.

Alcoholic beverages shall only be served by adults (persons over 21). A member of the organizing committee of the event, or designee, shall have control over all serving of alcoholic beverages. Alcoholic beverages shall only served in accordance with Nevada State Law, and only to persons over 21. No alcohol beverages shall ever be served to a minor. In the case of an

infringement of this policy, the minor's parent(s)/guardian(s) will be contacted immediately. If the minor was served by an adult, appropriate legal authorities shall be contacted.

Alcoholic beverages shall not be served to intoxicated individuals. Any improper serving, consumption, or storage of alcohol on UUCLV property, or at UUCLV sanctioned or sponsored events, shall be reported to the Board of Trustees.
