

Policy Statement

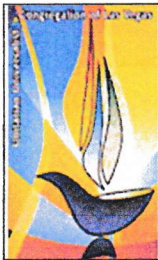
