Smoking Policy

Policy Statement


To protect the health and safety of UUCLV members and visitors and to protect the cleanliness and appearance of the facilities, this policy will govern the use of tobacco, e-cigarettes and similar products on church property.

Procedures

This Policy will serve to:

- Prohibit the use of tobacco, e-cigarettes and other devices used to consume nicotine or other similar compounds found in cigarettes by any individual within the building structures of UUCLV.
- Prohibit the use of any smoking or use of other products on the exterior premises except in an area designated by the UUCLV Facilities Committee and approved by the Board of Trustees.
 - Designation of an area in the exterior is not required by this policy.
 - Any designated area may be changed or modified as necessary by the Board of Trustees to meet the needs of the Congregation and protect the health and safety of members and visitors.
 - Any product or device used must be properly and safely disposed in appropriate waste containers.

- Prohibit any organization or individual using the facilities under a rental or usage agreement from using tobacco, ecigarettes and other devices inside or outside the UUCLV property. Any violation of this section will result in forfeiture of any deposits made for cleaning and security.
- Address any violations of the policy above with any individual observed using tobacco, e-cigarettes and other devices. They will be asked to stop using the product or device immediately, and safely and appropriately dispose of the product or device.
- Allow any individual refusing to cooperate to be asked to leave the premises.
